

TRAVEL PERMIT GUIDELINES

IMPORTANT: In order to obtain a **TRAVEL PERMIT** from Hockey PEI, team officials must abide by the following guidelines. Failure to follow these guidelines will result in delays in receiving a travel permit.

- Please allow 10 business days for processing of Travel Permit. Permits can be submitted to kris@hockeypei.com
- All required information and signatures must be included on application or application will be returned.
- Official team rosters (required) will not be issued unless the complete team roster is entered into the Hockey Canada Registry (by Association Registrar).
- GAME SHEETS/ SUSPENSIONS Team Officials must immediately submit any game sheet that has an incident or suspendable offence to the Hockey PEI Minor Hockey Suspension Coordinator at suspensions@hockeypei.com.
