### ALCOHOL POLICY

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The goal of hockey is to foster a love of the game and to seek to enhance the skills and abilities of each player as a member of a team. Team building is an important part of that development and is encouraged at all levels.

It is the responsibility of team management to ensure that all team building events meet all legal requirements of society.

All public functions organized by a team must be under the supervision of a designated coach or manager. Functions involving the availability of alcohol must not include under aged participants unless the premises are licensed to accommodate minors . --i.e. licensed restaurant for a sit down team meal. (this could be done in a club or legion as well). Where a premise is able to accommodate both groups, it is the responsibility of the team management (coaches and manager) to make certain that under aged persons associated with the team are neither served alcohol nor have alcohol purchased for them

Failure to ensure the safety of the under aged players at a team function will result in a suspension to the coach or manager responsible for the function. This suspension will be for a minimum of two years or more at the discretion of the Hockey PEI Discipline and Ethics Committee.

Hockey PEI will not be responsible for any liabilities accruing from teams or individuals failing to abide by this policy.
