Re: Junior Rec League

As a result of some interest within the hockey community, Hockey PEI created a working group to explore the possibility of establishing a Junior Rec League program for male players between the ages of 18-23.

After a call to the hockey community we received some interest from players to consider playing in a league. Following that we decided to explore options for possible ice times that could be used to establish a league for this coming season.

The working group was able to secure some ice times for the league, however the times and most importantly the locations were not extremely attractive to serve the market of players we were targeting. We believe to make this a viable league for players we must need to secure ice times in the capital region in order to ensure success.

Thus after several meetings and consultations and a dedicated effort, we are disappointed to confirm that we do not feel we can operate a league for this season. In our opinion, there was a lot of interest, but have concern if there would be enough commitment at this stage.

Although we will not operate a league for the current season, we are committed to continuing to work on this project in the hopes of establishing a viable and successful league for future years.

There is work to be done, but we at Hockey PEI and our working group are committed to continue to pursue this project. We thank those individuals that showed an interest and we will continue to keep you in informed as we proceed.
