Re: Respect in Sport Parent Program

As a follow up to the Minor Council AGM and recommendations brought forward by Minor Council and Hockey Development Council. The following policy will take affect for the 2013-2014 season regarding Respect in Sport (RIS) Parent Program.

At minimum one parent/guardian of every registered IP/Novice player in the branch, must complete the RIS Parent Program by December 31st of the current hockey season. This is a one time requirement per family.

We will further outline in detail at the Fall Presidents Workshop some different scenarios, situations that may exist in relation to completing this program.

The cost to complete this on-line program is \$12.00 per user and will be billed to each Minor Hockey Association similar to the other RIS program for team officials. The Hockey PEI Board of Directors has approved funding for this initiative and will cover 50% of the cost for each user and thus only charge \$6 per user to the association.

At this time, we wanted to advise you of the funding formula and will provide further details by the fall workshop on the delivery of this program.
