



Hockey PEI Officials Certification Requirements

Listed below are the certification requirements for all HPEI officials. Officials are to complete all three requirements in order to be certified for upcoming season. All requirements are to be completed by November 30 of the calendar year.

**A minimum mark of 80% is required on the HPEI Officials exam for all minor hockey officials. Member High Performance Officials' minimum mark is 90%

**Officials over the age of 18 are required to have a Criminal Record Check with vulnerable sector completed. Consult with your minor hockey association for more details. (If you submitted one for the previous years, it is valid for 3 years)

New Officials:

Complete the Hockey University Officiating 1/2 Online Clinic.
Attend an in-person HPEI Official 1/2 Clinic and on-ice session.

Level 1 (Returning) and 2 Minor Hockey Officials:

Attend an in-person HPEI Official Level 1/2 Clinic and on-ice session.

Level 3 Minor Hockey Officials:

Attend an in-person HPEI Official Level 3 Clinic.
Complete the HPEI Officials examination (in-person)

Member High Performance Officials:

Contact HPEI's Manager of Officiating to get approval to certify at this level.
Attend the in-person Member High Performance Clinic.
Attend the in-person Member High Performance Fitness session(s).
Complete the HPEI Officials examination (in-person)
Pay a \$200.00 Registration Fee.
